Retrieving Your Softchalk Content

- 1. Login at wvnet.softchalkcloud.com/login
- 2. Go to 'My Content' and click 'Lessons'



- 3. Click on the Lesson you wish to Download.
- 4. Scroll down below the Lesson Preview area and click 'Download SCORM Package'.



5. Apply grade options and choose 'Create.' This will download your lesson as a SCORM package. This will be saved on your computer in your Downloads folder by default. Access your downloads by holding the Ctrl key and tapping the 'J' key (\Re + J on Mac OS).

- 6. Navigate to the Brightspace course you wish to store the Lesson. Your personal sandbox is a good place to store all of your lessons. Storing all your lessons in one centralized location will make it easier to copy them to other courses.
- In the course chosen in Step #6, navigate to the Content area. *If using the Classic Content Experience, click 'Upload/Create'*. *If using the New Content Experience, click 'Add Existing'*. Select the option for SCORM/xAPI.
- 8. In the Add Course Package window, click the 'Bulk Upload' button.
